



Font size:

- Title slide: title: 65pt, subtitle: 25pt, date 20pt, event type: 16pt
- General slide: titles: 30pt, body: 25pt

Visual:

- Use Gray for all but title slide
- White and yellow text needs to be slightly larger in general for legibility
- Maintain at least a .25" boarder
- Horizontally center text boxes
- Set titles about 1" to the left of text box/ image
- Decorative triangle should always be aligned with text
